The conference welcomes proposals in the following formats:

- I. Academic Papers: We invite submissions of abstracts for original research papers from all relevant disciplines. Papers should be grounded in rigorous methodology, and their findings should contribute to the theoretical empirical, or policy-oriented knowledge in the field.
- Posters: We encourage the submission of poster presentations that succinctly convey the essence of the research or project. Posters should be visually engaging and clearly communicate the research question, methodology, findings and implications.
- 3. **Book Symposium:** Authors who have recently published or are soon to publish a book related to the conference theme are invited to submit proposals for book displays in an online platform format. These sessions will provide an opportunity for authors to talk about their work and engage in discussions with the audience during a conference.
